

Admissions

Qualifications (at the Time of Application)

▶ Undergraduate:

This program is open to foreign Undergraduate/Bachelor's Degree level (#Associate Degree) students who are currently enrolled to their home universities outside of Korea as full-time students, and have completed two (2) semesters (or the equivalent) **BEFORE** the nomination/application period.

► Transfer Undergraduate / Graduate:

For Undergraduate/Bachelor's Degree level transfer students or Graduate/Master's Degree level students, a minimum of one semester's results from the current university must appear on their official transcripts.

▶ Minimum GPA

- For Exchange and Group Visiting student: CGPA 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- For Individual Visiting student: CGPA 3.0 on a 4.0 scale

► Language Proficiency (either English or Korean)

- 1. English: Either one of the followings is accepted.
 - TOEFL iBT or iBT Home Edition: score 79 or above (ITP or MyBest score is NOT accepted)
 - IELTS: score 6.5 above
 - Cambridge English Qualifications: FCE(B2 first) or above (including CAE or CPE)
- 2. Korean: Either one of the followings is accepted.
 - KI AT level 4
 - TOPIK level 4
 - An assessment report by a professor

* Exception:

- 1) A national from majority native English speaking countries (Americas, United Kingdom, Hong Kong, Singapore, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland): Passport is required
- 2) Current home university is in majority native English speaking countries (Americas, United Kingdom, Hong Kong, Singapore, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland): N/A, but it must be specified in the transcript or Certificate of Enrollment
- 3) Current degree program is held 100% English: Home university letter is required

Course Restrictions

- √ Courses offered by the Department of Business Administration are ONLY available to exchange/visiting students who are majoring in a business-related field at their home institution AND have chosen Business Administration as their Yonsei major in their SAY application. Students who qualify may take a maximum of 4 BIZ courses (12 credits) only.
- $\sqrt{\text{Graduate courses}}$ are strictly open to graduate level students and senior(4th-year) level undergraduate students only. In addition, senior(4th-year) level undergraduates can register up to 1 graduate course only, and the course must be open to undergraduates (not all graduate level courses are open to 4th-year level undergraduates).
- $\sqrt{\text{Courses open in Songdo International Campus are restricted to SAY students.}}$

Center of Youth Culture


Located in Sinchon-Hongdae area, Yonsei is conveniently connected with iconic places in Seoul, such as Gangnam, Itaewon, etc.
