Semester Fulfillment	- For Undergraduate/Bachelor's Degree level transfer students or Graduate/Master's Degree level students, a minimum of one semester's results from the university must appear on their official transcripts.		
	 * The official transcript uploaded must show average grades obtained to this date. It must include <u>all of the completed semesters results</u>, not just limited to the student's most recent study year. * It must be in English, signed or stamped by home university (Digital signature is accepted). 		
GPA	 Minimum GPA for Application: CGPA 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (no other grade scales will be accepted whatsoever) * If student's transcript does not show the grading in GPA out of 4.0 scale, then students MUST submit the "Confirmation of Student Information Form" (downloadable from our application system) additionally.
